Inhalation protocol Ellipta®

Patient information

1. Discuss the purpose and the mode of action of the medication.

Preparation

Before the first use

2. The Ellipta[®] is sealed in foil, remove this foil right before the first use.

Before every use

- 3. The mouth must be empty.
- 4. Hold the Ellipta[®] upright with the cap at the upper side.
- 5. Open the Ellipta[®] by sliding the cap down until you hear a 'click'. The dose counter has been turned on.
- 6. The Ellipta[®] is now ready for use.

Inhalation

- 7. Sit or stand up straight with your head slightly backwards.
- 8. Exhale slowly and fully, not into the Ellipta[®].
- 9. Bring the Ellipta [®] horizontal towards your mouth.
- 10. Put the mouthpiece between teeth and close lips to form good seal. Make sure the air vents are open and are facing upwards.
 - 11. Inhale as deeply as possible with steady, moderate force.
 - 12. Hold breath for 10 seconds or as long as comfortable. Meanwhile remove the Ellipta® from the mouth.
- 13. Exhale slowly.
 - 14. Clean the mouthpiece with a dry tissue, never rinse it with water.
 - 15. Close the Ellipta[®] by sliding the cap back until you hear a 'click'.
 - 16. After inhalation, rinse your mouth briefly with water: gargle and spit with the first mouthful then swallow the second mouthful. If needed eat or drink something.

17. Clean the mouthpiece only directly after inhalation, before the cap has been slide back. See step 14.

Important points

- 18. The Ellipta[®] contains 30 inhalations, the dose counter indicates the number of doses remaining.
- 19. Keep the Ellipta[®] at room temperature. Do not keep the Ellipta[®] in the bathroom or kitchen.
- 20. If the cap has been opened and closed without inhalation, the dose will be lost.
- □ 21. The Ellipta[®] is preservable for 6 weeks after the first use.
