	1.	Discuss the purpose and the mode of action of the medication.

Wash For a been	the in new rused	nhaler Volumatic® before the first use. Then wash it every week, see the heading Cleaning. metered-dose inhaler: shake the inhaler well and spray three doses; if the inhaler has not for one week or longer: shake the inhaler well and spray one dose.		
	2.	The mouth must be empty.		
	3.	Assemble the Volumatic®.		
	4.	Check the function of the flap (when you shake the Volumatic®, you should hear the flap).		
		Remove the cap from the inhaler.		
	5.	Shake the inhaler well.		
	6.	Put the inhaler with the opening downwards into the Volumatic®.		
	7.	The inh <mark>aler with the Volum</mark> atic® is now ready for use.

	8.	Sit or stand up straight with your head slightly backwards.		
	9.	Put the mouthpiece between teeth and close lips to form a good seal. Make sure the exhale		
		vents are not covered.		
	10.	- Exhale completely.		
		- Press down on the inhaler canister once at the start of a slow inhalation.		
		 Breathe 5 times slowly in and out through the Volumatic®, you should hear the flap open and close.

		Remove the inhaler from the Volumatic®, put the cap back on.		
	13.	After inhaling corticosteroids, rinse your mouth briefly with water: gargle and spit with the first mouthful then swallow the second mouthful. If needed eat or drink something.

☐ 18.	Estimate when the inhaler will be empty. The number of doses the inhaler contains, is listed on the side of the inhaler. Count the dosages and note the start date. Some inhalers have a
	dose counter to tell you exactly how many doses are left. Keep the inhaler at room temperature. Replace the Volumatic® once a year. The function of the air valve may deteriorate over time
