# Inhalation protocol Turbospin®

### **Patient information**

1. Discuss the purpose and the mode of action of the medication.

### Preparation

#### Before every use:

- The mouth must be empty.
- 3. Make sure there is a clean, dry worktop. Put a glass of water within reach.
- 4. Wash and dry both hands.
- 5. Remove the cap from the Turbospin<sup>®</sup> by pulling it upwards.
- 6. Hold the center part of the Turbospin<sup>®</sup> and unscrew the mouthpiece (counterclockwise). Put the mouthpiece on the worktop.
- 7. Put the Turbospin<sup>®</sup> upright on the worktop.
- B. Just before use, take one capsule from the strip. Do not force the capsule through the foil.
  Put the capsule directly into Turbospin<sup>®</sup>.
- 9. Hold the Turbospin<sup>®</sup>, put the mouthpiece back and rotate the Turbospin<sup>®</sup> with the white button pointing upwards.
- 10. Puncture the capsule by pressing the button with your thumb and release the button. During the puncture, some of the medicine may have left the Turbospin® through the air vents.
- 11. The Turbospin<sup>®</sup> is now ready for use. Do not make any sudden moves.

## Inhalation

- 12. Have a sip of water.
- 13. Sit or stand up straight with your head slightly backwards.
- 14. Exhale slowly and completely, not into the Turbospin<sup>®</sup>.
- 15. Bring the Turbospin<sup>®</sup> horizontal towards the mouth.
- 16. Put the mouthpiece between teeth and close lips to form a good seal. Do not block the air vents.
- 17. Inhale as deeply as possible with steady, moderate force.
- 18. Hold breath for 10 seconds or as long as comfortable. Meanwhile remove the Turbospin<sup>®</sup> from the mouth.
- 19. Exhale slowly and take a short break.
  - ] 20. Rep<mark>eat steps 13</mark> to 19 once.

- 21. Unscrew the mouthpiece of the Turbospin<sup>®</sup> and remove the capsule. Please note:
  - If the capsule is empty: it can be disposed.
  - If the capsule has been punctured, but it is not empty: put the capsule back with the puncture holes on the lower side. Put the mouthpiece back on and repeat inhalation.
  - If the capsule is full and has not been punctured: put the capsule back and puncture it again. Repeat inhalation.
  - In case the capsule has not been punctured the second time, use the spare Turbospin<sup>®</sup>.
  - 22. After inhaling, rinse your mouth briefly with water: gargle and spit with the first mouthful then swallow the second mouthful. If needed eat or drink something.

#### Cleaning

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- 23. Remove the mouthpiece and shake the Turbospin<sup>®</sup> well.
- 24. Clean the mouthpiece and chamber with a dry tissue or a cotton swab, never rinse it with water.
- 25. Put back the mouthpiece and protection cap.

### Important points

- 26. After inhalation, a patient might have to cough intensely. For future use, the patient may be advised to inhale slower.
- 27. Only the included capsules fit in the Turbospin<sup>®</sup>. Inhale the included capsules through the Turbopin<sup>®</sup> after all other medication is inhaled.
- 28. Keep the Turbospin<sup>®</sup> and the included capsules at room temperature. Do not keep them in the bathroom or kitchen.
- 29. Replace the Turbospin<sup>®</sup> every month: use a new Turbospin<sup>®</sup> when the monthly dosage changes.
