	1.	Discuss the purpose and the mode of action of the medication.

\Box	2.	Open the transparent cover of the side chamber.				
	3.	Remove the black striped foil strip from the side chamber, against the perforation line.				
Befo	re ev	very use:				
\Box	4.	The mouth must be empty.				
	5.	Hold the Forspiro® upright with the protective cap facing up.				
	6.	Open the protective cap of the Forspiro®.				
	7.	Open the white lever, and move it as far open as it will go and until it clicks.				
	8.	Close the white lever so that it will click again into its original position. The dose counter				
		starts counting now.				
	9.	The Forspiro ® is now ready for use.				
Inh	alat	ion				
	10.	Sit or s <mark>tand up straight wi</mark> th your head slight <mark>ly ba</mark> ckwards.				
	11.	Exhale slowly and completely, not into the Forspiro®.				
	12.	Bring the Forspiro® horizontal towards the mouth.				
	13.	Put the mouthpiece between teeth and close lips to form good seal, make sure the air vents are not covered.				
	14.	Inhale as deeply as possible with steady, moderate force.				
	15.	Hold breath for 10 seconds or as long as comfortable. Meanwhile remove the Forspiro® from				
		the mouth.				
	16.	Exhale slowly.				
	17.	Repeat steps 7 to 16, if a second inhalation is prescribed.				
	18.	Close the Forspiro® by putting the protective cap back over the mouth piece.				
	19.	Open the transparent cover of the side chamber.				

Cleaning

22. Clean the mouthpiece with a dry cloth, never rinse it.

21. After inhaling corticosteroids, rinse your mouth briefly with water: gargle and spit with the first mouthful then swallow the second mouthful. If needed, eat or drink something.

20. Remove the empty strips by ripping it off, against the perforation line.
