For the age of 0 to 12 months: small mask and a Space Chamber® compact
For the age of 1 year to 4 years: medium mask and Space Chamber® plus.
For the age from 4 years, if conscious inhalation with mouthpiece is not possible: either the adult mask (large) or the medium mask, which has a better fit, and the Space Chamber® plus.

		effective seal over mouth and nose.
	13.	- Press down on the inhaler canister once at the start of inhalation.

		to keep an effective seal and that there are no tears on the child's cheeks. The air vents

	14.	If an extra dose is prescribed, remove the inhaler from the Space Chamber® and repeat steps
		8 to 13.

15. Remove the inhaler from the Space Chamber®. Put the cap back on the inhaler.





	16.	After inhaling corticosteroids, rinse your mouth briefly with water: gargle and spit with the first mouthful then swallow the second mouthful. If needed eat or drink something. Wash the face as well.

		Clean the Space Chamber® once a week.  Dismantle the Space Chamber®. Remove the pull it out).
	20.	Wash all parts of the inhaler in lukewarm, (clean) soapy water.  Do not wash or dry the Space Chamber®.
	21.	Let the Space Chamber® air dry. Make sure the components are dry before the Space Chamber® is assembled.

	22.	Estimate when the inhaler will be empty. The number of doses which the inhaler contains is listed on the side of the inhaler. Recommended is to tally the doses and note the date of embarking. Some inhalers have a dose counter to tell you exactly how many doses are left.
		Keep the inhaler at room temperature.  Replace the Space Chamber® once a year.
