	1.	Discuss the purpose and the mode of action of the medication.

	2.	Remove the cap from both the inhaler .		
	3.	Shake the inhale <mark>r well and spr</mark> ay three doses.

	4.	Remove the cap from both the inhaler.		
	5.	If the inhaler hasn't been used for a week, shake th <mark>e inhaler well</mark> and spray one dose.		
	6.	The mouth has to be empty.		
	7.	Shake the inhaler well.		
	8.	Put the in <mark>haler with th</mark> e opening downwards straight into of the Inspir <mark>aChamber</mark> ®.		
	9.	The inha <mark>ler with the Insp</mark> iraChamber® is now ready for use.

П	10.	Sit or stand up straight with your head slightly backwards.		
		Hold the InspiraChamber® horizontal and apply mask to face and ensure an effective seal		
		over mouth and nose.		
	12.	- Exhale completely.		
		- Press down the inhaler canister once at the start of a slow inhalation.		
		- Inhale and exhale slowly 5 times through the InspiraChamber®. Inhale with less		
		force if the inhaler gives a 'whistle' sound. Make sure the mask has a goo <mark>d seal until</mark> the		
		patient is done.		
	13.	If an extra dose is prescribed, shake the inhaler with the InspiraChamber® well and repeat		
		steps 7 to 12. Do not press more than one dose into the InspiraChamber®.		
		Remove the inhaler from the InspiraChamber®, put the cap back on the inhaler.		
	15.	After inhaling, rinse your mouth briefly with water: gargle and spit with the first mouthful		
		then swallow the second mouthful. If needed eat or drink something, and wash the face.

	16.	Clean the InspiraChamber® once a week.
	17.	Dismantle the InspiraChamber®. Remove the backpiece and the mask of the InspiraChamber®.
	18.	Wash all parts of the inhaler in lukewarm, (clean) soapy water.
	19.	Rinse the InspiraChamber® but do not dry it.
	20.	Leave the InspiraChamber® to air dry.
	21.	Make sure the compon <mark>ents a</mark> re dry bef <mark>ore t</mark> he InspiraChamber ® is <mark>asse</mark> mbled.

	22.	Estimate when the inhaler will be empty. The number of doses which the inhaler contains is listed on the side of the inhaler. A suggestion is to tally the doses and put down the date o embarking. Some inhalers have a dose counter to tell you exactly how many doses are left.
	23.	Keep the inhaler at room temperature.
	24.	R <mark>eplace the</mark> InspiraChamber® once a <mark>year.</mark>
