	2. 3. 4. 5. Sha 6.	The mouth must be empty.  Keep the Aerochamber® horizontal.  Remove the cap.  Put the inhaler with the opening downwards into the Aerochamber®.  ke the inhaler well.  Shake the inhaler with Aerochamber® well. The inhaler with Aerochamber® is now ready for use.

	7. 8. 9a.	Sit or stand up straight with your head slightly backwards.  Put the mouthpiece between teeth and close lips to form a good seal.  Standard method:  Exhale slowly and completely.	
	- 9b. -	Press down on the inhaler canister once at the start of inhalation. (The Flow-Vu indicator will move towards the mouth).  Inhale and exhale slowly 5 times through the Aerochamber®.  If the standard method is not pleasant: one-breath method:  Exhale slowly and completely.  Press down on the inhaler canister once at the start of inhalation. (The Flow-Vu indicator	
		will move towards the mouth).  Inhale once slowly and as deeply as possible. Hold breath for 10 seconds.  If the inhaler 'whistles' during the inhalation, inhale with less force.  If an extra dose is prescribed, repeat steps 6 to 10.	

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13. After inhaling corticosteroids, rinse your mouth briefly with water: gargle and spit with the first mouthful then swallow the second mouthful. If needed eat or drink something.

12. Remove the inhaler from the Aerochamber®, put the cap back on.

	15. 16.	Dismantle the Aerochamber®.  Wash all parts of the inhaler in lukewarm, clean, and soapy water.  Do not rinse or dry the Aerochamber®.  Let the Aerochamber® air dry.		
Important points				
	18.	Estimate when the inhaler will be empty. The number of doses which the inhaler contains is listed on the side of the inhaler. Count the dosages and note the start date. Some inhalers have a dose counter to tell you exactly how many doses are left.		
	19.	Keep the inhaler at room temperature. Please be cautious of possible mould formation at the mouthpiece of the Aerochamber®.		
	20.	Replace the Aerochamber® once a year.
