	1.	Discuss the purpose and the mode of action of the medication.

	2. 3. 4.	The mouth must be empty Keep the Diskus® horizontal, with the counter facing up. Just before using the Diskus®, open it by pushing the thumb grip all the way over until yo hear a 'click', then slide the lever down until you hear another 'click'. The Diskus® is now ready for use. Do not tilt or shake the device once primed.

	12. 13. 14.	Sit or stand up straight with your head slightly backwards. Exhale slowly and completely, not into the Diskus®. Bring the Diskus® horizontally towards the mouth. Put the mouthpiece between teeth and close lips to form a good seal. Inhale as deeply as possible with steady, moderate force. Hold breath for 10 seconds or as long as comfortable. Meanwhile remove the Diskus® from the mouth. Exhale slowly, not into the Diskus®. Close the Diskus® by sliding the thumb grip back toward you until you hear a 'click'. If an extra dose is prescribed, repeat steps 4 to 13. After inhaling corticosteroids, rinse your mouth briefly with water: gargle and spit with the first mouthful then swallow the second mouthful. If needed eat or drink something.
